2. God speaks truth to Lucifer: “You have tried to cloud their understanding of My perfect love.”

Give some examples or how your understanding of God is now or was clouded by circumstances, relationships, misunderstandings, or inaccurate beliefs about God or your own self-worth. If you have gained clarity, share about one way you have experienced God’s perfect love.

3. God: “I built the desire to know Me into them.” God brings Lucifer to a volcanic lava flow rocky space that looks barren and is void of any green or growth; far to each side is green and trees. He uses this landscape to demonstrate that sin brings a finite divide, and that only way to safely cross the divide is through Jesus His Son.

If you are a Jesus follower, what brought you to the point where you chose to allow Jesus to lead you across that barren divide?

4. Lucifer makes the comment that some see the path and don’t even know it is there, and others deny that the other side of eternity even exists.

Was there a time when one of those perspectives described your position? What happened to change your mind about God and Jesus?

Or, if one of those ideas represents your current thinking, is there some visual or conversation in the film that has given you a new awareness or brought questions to mind?

5. What emotion did you experience when God explained to Lucifer that it is still His time of mercy and grace, He is allowing enough time for many to come, and still more will come to Him?

She is reflecting His beauty, His holiness, and that is what I see.” God proclaimed. “My spotless bride is emerging victorious, and has the heart of a servant.... My Son is the ultimate servant and My faithful ones follow Him (Jesus) willingly, and even joyfully, out of great gratitude.”
